During the tour, students were shown the different stages of the production process like Water Treatment- Syrup Preparation- Mixing- Carbonation- Bottling- Quality Control of Sprite, coke of various quantity and also the packing process. They also explained about the process in which the quality check will be conducted in the lab. The group left the COCO COLA industry at 1.00 pm and reached College at 4.00 pm.



The students actively participated in the discussions, asking insightful questions about automation systems and quality control processes. One of the key takeaways was the integration of various processes in the production line to produce different products.
