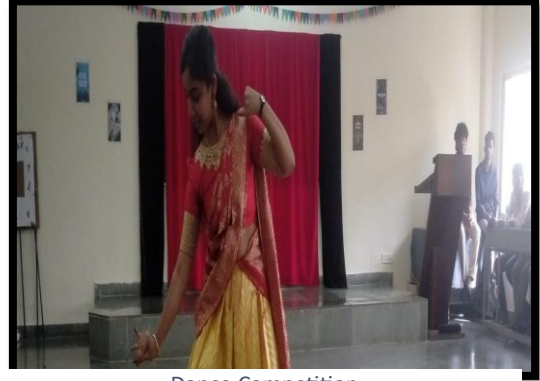
Story Telling Competition
